**Bylaw 2008 – 02:**

**The Members of the Local Services Board of Loring, Port Loring and District enact as follows:**

**A Bylaw for Perceived Bias:**

- 1. A member of the LSB or any of it's sub committees, if known or perceived to be in a position of perceived bias, by oneself or by a quorum vote of the board may:
  - A.) Voluntarily excuse himself or herself from a vote or committee when in this position.**
  - B.) Be asked by the Board with a majority vote to excuse themselves from a vote or a committee when in this position.****

**Definition of Perceived Bias: Perceived bias may exist if a Board Member has another role in the community that might be seen to influence the member's conduct or view. For example, if a Board Member is an employee or elected official within the community (or is married to one). Others may question whether the member is acting solely in the interests of the council.**

- 2. This bylaw shall become effective upon date of enactment.**
